



Lynn & Susan Purdy's front yard is very distinct from your typical lawn and driveway landscape. Their large front yard consists of no lawn, but instead has many interesting and beautiful plants that thrive in our Southern California climate. There are several trees dispersed on the property, all of which are drought tolerant, like Crape Myrtle and Australia native Paperbark trees. The landscape also consists of a variety of blossoming shrubs, ground cover, and long growing grasses. While this yard has no lawn, it is still full of many shades of green. The lush plants and trees only require irrigation three times a week! The Purdy's 4,000 square foot front yard is attractive and colorful, yet requires very little water like a desert, making their design a great variation of a water efficient landscape.
